

ISLE OF MAN POLICY AND GUIDELINES FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL SWIMMING

Verrucas - The use of a waterproof plaster is sufficient to cover the verruca during lessons (see updated guidelines for further information)

Appropriate clothing must be worn by ALL pupils during swim lessons:

No baggy shorts are allowed to be worn

No Bikinis and loose clothing

Children with long hair (fringe passes eyebrows when wet) MUST wear swimming hats

*** PUPILS NOT WEARING THE APPROPRIATE CLOTHING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN THE LESSON**

All Jewellery must be removed by pupils prior to taking part in the lessons.

If a child can not yet remove their earrings then they MUST be covered by a swimming head band. (These headbands will no longer be provided by the swimming pools).

*** PUPILS WHO CANNOT REMOVE or APPROPRIATELY COVER THEIR EARRINGS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN THE LESSON *** (Waterproof plasters will not be deemed as appropriate)

Wrist bands must not be worn.

Appropriate footwear to be worn by all adults on poolside

All adults to sign in at the poolside registers

School teachers are responsible for the changing of pupils

School teachers are responsible for ensuring that the class medical bag is available on poolside if required and that medical/behavioural conditions are passed to the swim teachers

All teachers/poolside helpers are under the guidance of the swim teachers and must adhere to any instructions given
